Turning Summer Work Into Season Success

As we transition from the offseason into the 2026-27 season, one of the biggest takeaways for parents is that consistent habits matter more than occasional big workouts. Players who continue to spend even 15-20 minutes a day on ball handling, shooting form, footwork, or finishing will often make greater long-term progress than players who only train once in a while. Just as important, encourage your athlete to arrive at practices ready to listen, compete, and communicate. Those habits are what help players earn trust from coaches and become great teammates. The goal of the offseason isn't perfection; it's building confidence, discipline, and a love for the game that carries into every practice and tournament this year.
